Year 11 Destinations 2018:

This chart compares the 2018 Year 11 cohort to the previous years:

51% of the cohort went on to CNS sixth form to study A' levels.

One student went to study at a private sixth form.

Of the 52 who went to college 25 enrolled on a level 3 courses, 17 on level 2, 8 on level 1 and 2 on Pathways.

This year there was an increase in the number of students who gained apprenticeships straight from school (14).

This year we had 5 students in the 'other' category. One student doing an on-line course, two students educated elsewhere, one student working with BYHP in Banbury and OX7, one student has gone to an International school and one student NEET (not in education, employment or training). This student was offered a college place but could not make the transition to college this year and has been referred to Back on Track / OX7 for support.

Year 12 Destinations:

Of 82 students in Year 12, 81 moved into Year 13. One students decided to leave at the end of Year 12 and go to college to study a Level 3 course.

Year 13 Destinations:

Of the 78 students in Year 13, 47 went on to study at University. 9 students went on to a college of further education. 11 students went into employment / apprenticeships. There were 8 students taking a gap year and 3 restarting Y13.
