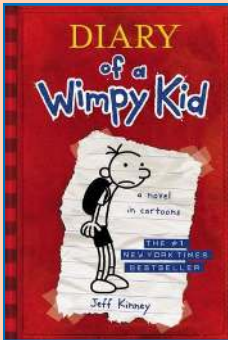

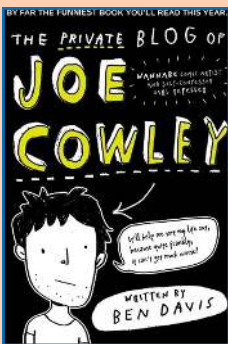


DIARY OF A WIMPY KID

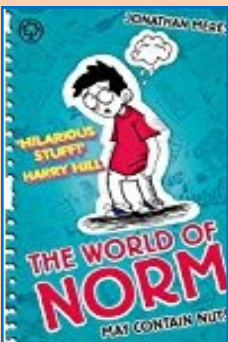


THE PRIVATE BLOG OF JOE COWLEY

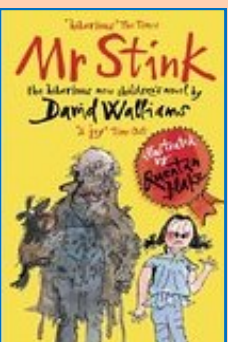


MAY CONTAIN NUTS

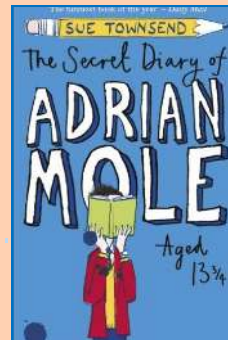


MR STINK

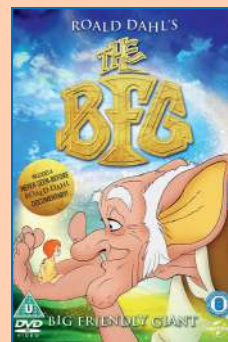


CAPTAIN UNDERPANTS AND THE PREPOSTEROUS PLIGHT OF THE PURPLE POTTY PEOPLE

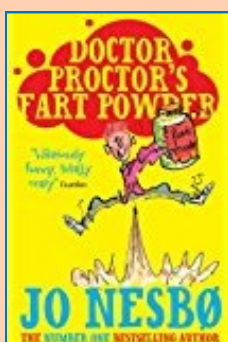


THE BFG

DOCTOR PROCTOR'S FART POWDER

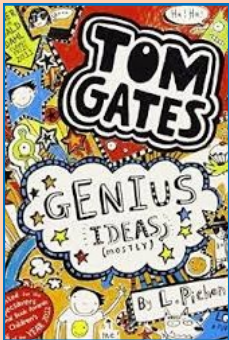

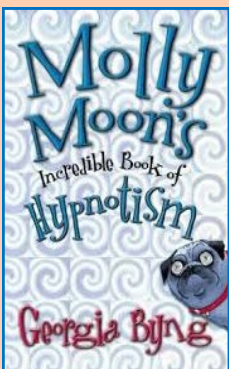

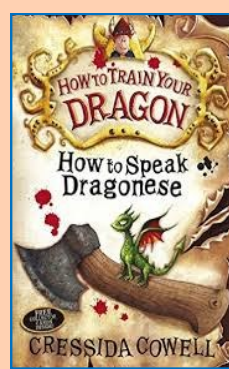


MOLLY MOON'S INCREDIBLE BOOK OF HYPNOTISM

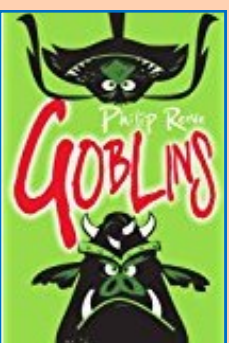


IT'S OK I'M WEARING REALLY BIG KNICKERS
