Additional Non Uniform Day – Friday 11th October 2019

Last week I learned of a local child called Anna Drysdale. Anna is in Year 4, attends Holy Trinity Primary School and is bravely fighting Osteosarcoma bone cancer. The little girl has a sister with us here at CNS and an older sister who has just left us and is now at university. Anna's family and parents are seeking help to raise funds to enable Anna to travel to the USA to receive new immunotherapy cancer treatment.

They have set up a Just Giving fundraising page and we want to try and help.

Therefore, on Friday 11th October 2019 we are inviting all students to come into school in non-school uniform. We ask that each student and member of staff donates £1 - £2 for the cause. *The donation will not be compulsory.*
