# RE: Arrangements for transfer to Chipping Norton School – September 2020

It has been a delight to visit some of the Primary Schools and introduce myself to the Year 6 pupils who are, understandably, excited and nervous about starting secondary school. I have been very impressed by the sensible questions that I have been asked and I hope that I have been able to address some of their worries or concerns.

We expect to return to normal in September and are planning the new term on this basis while ensuring that we have a contingency plan in place to ensure the safety of all our students, staff and the wider community.

#### **Buses**

The school buses are expected to be running as normal, albeit with reduced numbers of students at the moment whilst social distancing remains in place. If you need transport to us in September then you will need to book a seat on the school bus for your child(ren) by contacting Oxfordshire County Council in the normal way.
