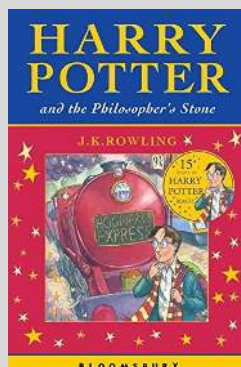

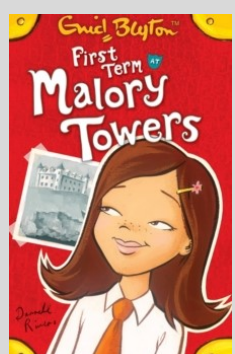


HARRY POTTER AND THE PHILOSOPHER'S STONE

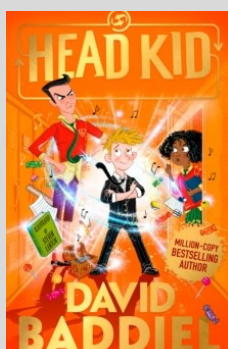


FIRST TERM AT MALORY TOWERS

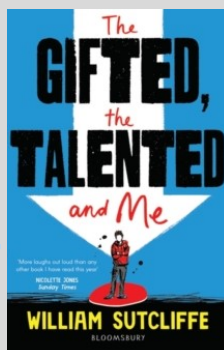


THERE'S A BOY IN THE GIRL'S BATHROOM

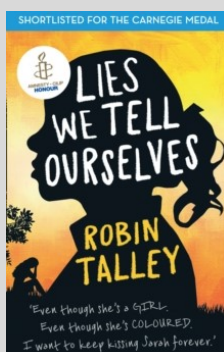
THE GIFTED, THE TALENTED AND ME

Gifted and Talented. Sam knows he'll never belong, even if he wanted to. AR: 5.5 322 pages

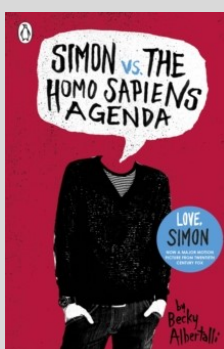


LIES WE TELL OURSELVES

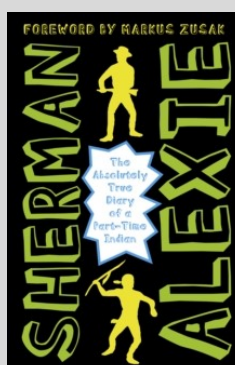


SIMON vs THE HOMOSAPIENS AGENDA

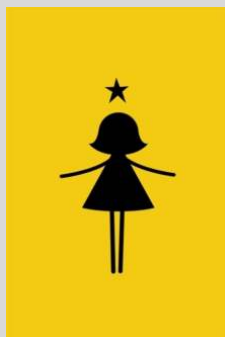

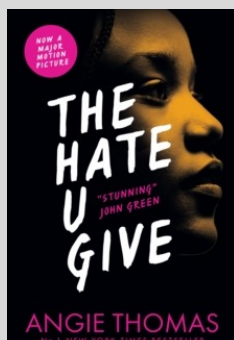

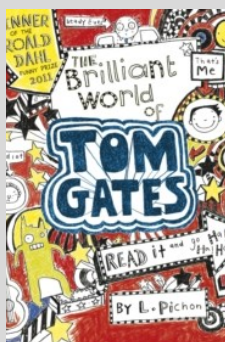

Suzanne Collins

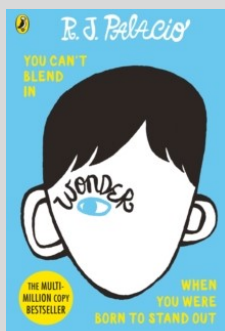

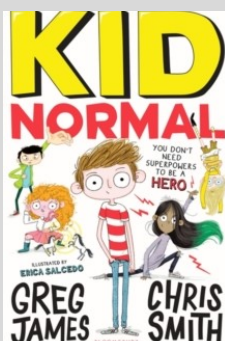

R. J. Palacio

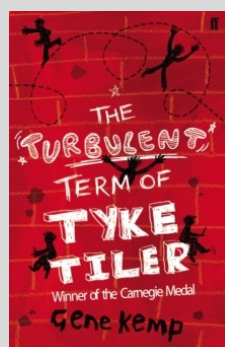
