<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a mobile phone during the times 8.40am to 3.15pm 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Behave in a way which disrupts the learning of others. <p>Students will receive strikes in a lesson for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> low level disruption Failing to complete sufficient work Persistently failing to bring correct equipment Engage in a single incident of serious misbehaviour that disrupts the entire lesson for more than 10 seconds. <p>Strike 1 = warning Strike 2 = after school detention 60 min (poor behaviour) or lunch detention 30 min (poor effort/organisation/failure to complete homework))</p> <p>Continued poor behaviour = immediate removal by duty staff (see column 6 *)</p> <p>In Tutor time:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will receive strikes in a tutor time for: failing to have correct equipment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use obscene language/ swear irrespective of whether or not it is directed at another person. Repeatedly arrive in school without the correct uniform and not follow the yellow slip procedure Be out of bounds (truant) at any time during the day. Engage in play-fighting, rough play or aggressive games with friends Drop litter Queue-jump in or outside the dining hall Inappropriate behaviour in the corridors (Running/shouting/ barging) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Smoke cigarettes/vape or be in the company of smokers/vapers at any point before, during or after the school day. Trespass onto the school grounds or site out of school hours. <p>(Referrals may be made to the school nurse for those students found to be smoking or vaping)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Refuse to follow a reasonable instruction given by a member of staff. Walk away without permission, from a member of staff making a reasonable request. Argue with a member of staff. Use social media to offend / harass others (in or out of school hours and days) Use social media to threaten or bully. Engage in fighting /aggressive / threatening or offensive language or physical contact towards another student (assault) (First incident) Engage in sexualised behaviour/child on child abuse (1st offence/low level/inappropriate comment) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possess or drink alcohol. Exhibit aggressive or threatening language or physical contact towards another student. Engage in Fighting/ aggressive / threatening language or physical contact towards another student (assault) - Repeat incident Steal or deliberately / carelessly damage school property. Steal or deliberately / carelessly damage other students' property. Refuse to be placed elsewhere in the school following 2 strikes and continued poor behaviour. Engage in sexualised behaviour/Peer on Peer abuse (repeat behaviour /contact) Engage in any prejudicial /discriminatory behaviour/language 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make any deliberate physical contact with a member of staff. Use threatening, obscene or offensive language directed at a member of staff. Take/Possess any drugs, alcohol, drug related materials, dangerous articles or weapons, with or without any intention to threaten or harm. Make a false or misleading allegation of misconduct against a member of staff Engage in sexualised behaviour/Peer on Peer abuse (serious offence)

<p>Mobile phone offences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1st time – confiscated and lunchtime detention ● 2nd time – confiscated and after school detention 	<p>Always results in 30 min lunch detention (equipment or organisational issues) or 60 min after school detention & phone call home (poor behaviour)</p> <p>In addition: Further disruption after 2nd strike will always results in the removal to another room by Duty Staff and 60 min afterschool detention. A R & R meeting with teacher</p>	<p>Always results in a 60 min after school detention.</p>	<p>Always results in 60 min after school detention + Phone call home.</p> <p>+ Up to two weeks of Leadership Team Supervision (LTS).</p> <p>+ Parents / carers required to escort their children on to the school site.</p>	<p>Always results in 60 min after school detention.
